41 And Jesus sat over against the treasury, and beheld how the people cast money into the treasury: and many that were rich cast in much.

42 And there came a certain poor widow, and she threw in two mites, which make a farthing.

43 And he called [unto him] his disciples, and saith unto them, Verily I say unto you, That this poor widow hath cast **MORE** in, than **ALL** they which have cast into the treasury:

44 For all [they] did cast in of their abundance (SURPLUS/WEALTH); but she of her want (POVERTY/NEED) did cast in **ALL** that she had, [even] **ALL** her living
