The miraculous power of Jesus does not assure us that we will have no loss or pain. But our text tells us what we can do in the midst of suffering and loss: **we can put our trust in the Lord.** Our ultimate destiny is a life in which the Lord wipes away our tears (Isaiah 25:8; Revelation 7:17).
