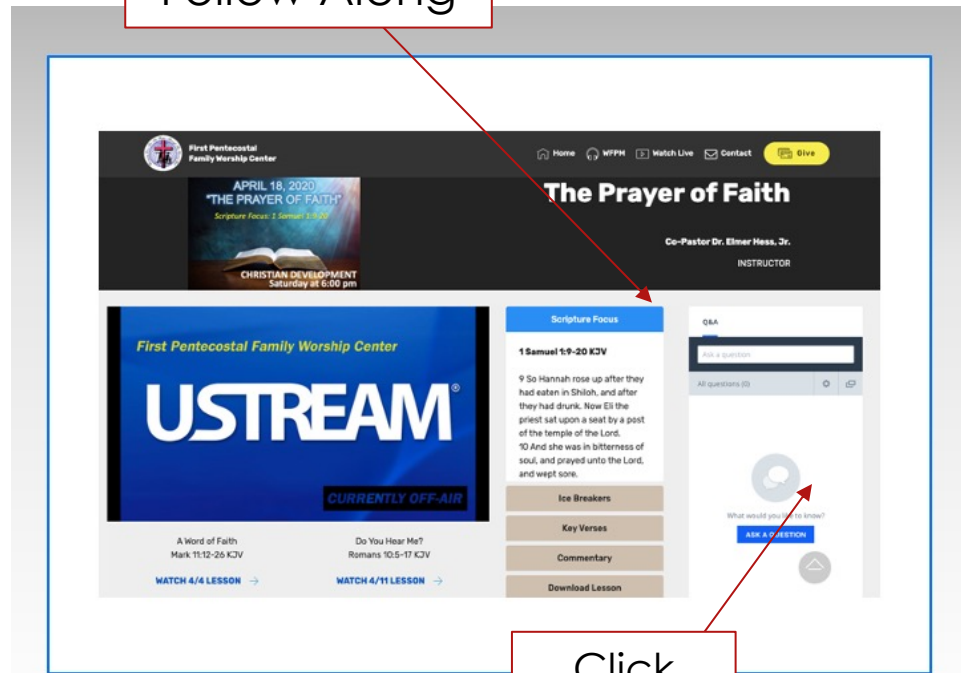

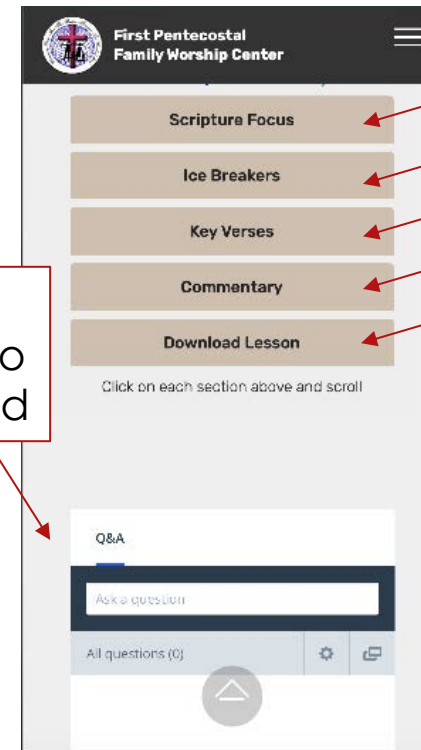

1ST PROVERB - YOU DON'T KNOW EVERYTHING YOU NEED TO KNOW

Proverbs 3:14 KJV

For the merchandise of it [is]
better than the merchandise of
silver, and the gain thereof than
fine gold.

2ND PROVERB – LEARN IT - LIVE IT

Proverbs 8:32 KJV

Now therefore hearken unto me,
O ye children: for blessed [are
they that] keep my ways.

3RD PROVERB – LIFE'S A CLASSROOM, LEARN EVERYWHERE YOU CAN FROM EVERYONE YOU CAN

Everywhere is a classroom - you must make
yourself a student always.

Proverbs 8:34 KJV

Blessed [is] the man that heareth me,
watching daily at my gates, waiting at the
posts of my doors.

- LIFE IS A CLASSROOM -

4th PROVERB – WISE PEOPLE ARE GENEROUS

Proverbs 14:21 KJV

He that despiseth his neighbour
sinneth: but he that hath mercy
on the poor, happy [is] he.

5th PROVERB – WISDOM WILL LEAD YOU TO GOD

Proverbs 16:20 KJV

He that handleth a matter wisely shall find good:
and whoso trusteth in the LORD, happy [is] he.

Proverbs 1:7 KJV

The beginning of wisdom is the fear of the Lord.

*If your wisdom points others to you,
that's not Godly Wisdom.*

6th PROVERB – GODLY WISDOM POINTS US TO GOD AND OTHERS TO GOD

Proverbs 20:7

The just (RIGHTEOUS) [man]
walketh in his integrity: his children
[are] blessed after him.

Principle - “Your Integrity affects others.”

7th PROVERB – FEAR IS A GOOD THING

Proverbs 28:14 KJV

Happy [is] the man that feareth
alway: but he that hardeneth his
heart shall fall into mischief.

8th PROVERB – THERE ARE SOME NON-NEGOTIABLES

Proverbs 29:18 KJV

Where [there is] no vision, the people perish: but he that keepeth the law, happy [is] he.

LAW = Wise people understand that there are non-negotiables...

STEPS TO WISDOM

1. Submit every area of your life to the Lord and ask Him to show you places that you've moved without seeking His guidance.
2. Humble yourself and recognize that you aren't always right and you don't always know it all.
 - a. Wisdom doesn't associate with pride

STEPS TO WISDOM

3. Recognize that God is not disappointed in you because you don't know what to do. He's happy that you recognize your need for Him.
4. Wait to move until you hear God speak.
 - a. In James it says we shouldn't expect to receive anything from God if our loyalty and trust are divided. Don't lose your faith that He is willing to give you wisdom in a certain area and start moving without Him.

STEPS TO WISDOM

5. Make it a point to invite God into the crossroad moments where you're overwhelmed with emotion and ask Him for perspective or insight on what to do.
 - a. A good place to start and a good question to ask is "What should I do?".
 - b. From there, filter what you hear with the Word of God.

James 3:17

But the wisdom from above is first of all pure. It is also peace loving, gentle at all times, and willing to yield to others. It is full of mercy and the fruit of good deeds. It shows no favoritism and is always sincere.
