



JULY LESSON OVERVIEW WISDOM IN THE GOSPELS

LESSON #1 - VINDICATING WISDOM

Matthew – The Gospel of the King "And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins."

Matthew 1:21 KJV

LESSON #2 – HE IS THE SON

Luke – The Gospel of the Son "For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost."

Luke 19:10 KJV

LESSON #3 – THE WISDOM OF JESUS

Mark 10:45 NIV

Mark – The Gospel of the Servant "For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many."

LESSON #4 – WISDOM TO FOLLOW

>John - The Gospel of God "But these are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing ye might have life through his name."

JOHN 14 OUTLINE JESUS SPEAKS TO THE DISCIPLES

I. THE CONSOLATION HE GIVES TO HIS DISCIPLES

John 14:1-4

- "I am going to prepare a place for you." (14:1-2)
- "When everything is ready, I will come and get you, so that you will always be with me where I am" (14:3-4)

John 14:5-31

- Jesus answers three questions asked of him by three disciples
- √Thomas and Jesus
- √Philip and Jesus
- ✓ Judas (not Judas Iscariot) and Jesus

A. Thomas and Jesus (14:5-7)

- ▶ 1. Thomas's question: "We haven't any idea where you are going, so how can we know the way?" (14:5).
- ▶ 2. Jesus' answer (14:6-7)
 a. "I am the way, the truth and the life" (14:6a).
 b. "No one can come to the Father except through me" (14:6b-7).

- B. Philip and Jesus (14:8-21)
- ▶ 1. Philip's question (14:8): "Lord, show us the Father and we will be satisfied."
- ▶ 2. Jesus' answer (14:9-21)
- a. He says anyone who has seen him has seen the Father (14:9).
- b. He says that he is in the Father and that the Father is in him (14:10).
- c. He says they will do greater things than he has done because he is going to the Father (14:11-14).
- d. He says he will ask the Father to send them the Holy Spirit (14:15-21).

- c. Judas (not Judas Iscariot) and Jesus (14:22-31)
- ▶ 1. Judas's question (14:22): "Lord, why are you going to reveal yourself only to us and not to the world at large?"
- ▶ 2. Jesus' answer (14:23-31)
- a. He says that he only reveals himself to those who love and obey him (14:23-24).
- b. He promises that the Holy Spirit will explain all this to them (14:25-26).
- c. He reminds them again of his departure and return (14:27-31).



1a–"Let not your heart be troubled" John 14:1, 27	1b–I worry about everything.	1c-That's because you're trying to handle everything by your own power!
2a-"In my Father's house are many mansions" (v. 2).	2b-	2c-
3a-"I go to prepare a place for you" (v. 2).	3b-	3c-
4a—"I am the way, the truth, and the life" (v. 6).	4b-	4c-
5a-"If ye had known me, ye should have known my Father also" (v. 7).	5b-	5c-
6a-"The words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself" (v. 10).	6b-	6c-
7a-"If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it" (v. 14).	7b-	7c-
