LOYALTY

RECONCILIATION

God is interested in reconciliation. - Dr Michael Yuseff

- Reconciliation cannot occur with gifts. Reconciliation is spiritual and a work of grace.
- Reconciliation Is Not The Ignoring of An Offense But The Forgiveness of An Offense. - Dr. Mike Murdock
- Reconciliation brings peace, protection, provision and proximity (nearness).

PEACEMAKER

Matthew 5:9 (KJV)

Blessed [are] the peacemakers: for they shall be called the children of God.

Romans 12:18 (KJV)

If it be possible, as much as lieth in you, live peaceably with all men.
