What is Worship?

WORSHIP NUGGETS

- 1. Worship requires INTENTIONALITY
- 2. Worship is A PRIORITY
- 3. Worship is PERSONAL
- 4. Worship happens when we are **HUNGRY FOR THE LORD**
- 5. Worship is JOYFUL

WORSHIP NUGGETS

- 6. To Worship, we must FIND JESUS
- 7. Worship requires a PROPER MOTIVE
- 8. Worship requires PREPARATION
- 9. Worship begins with THE HEART
- 10. Worship is REVEALED THROUGH TRUTH

How do you find the will of God? The wise men:

- 1. Followed the light God gave them;
- 2. Confirmed their steps by the Word of God; and...
- 3. Obeyed God without question and He led them each step of the way.

Note that they went home by "another way" (Matthew 2:12). Anyone who comes to Christ will go home another way and be a new creature (2 Corinthians 5:17).

CONCLUSION

Matthew's account demonstrates the need to remain open to the unexpected.

It encourages us to watch for God in action, even when (or especially when) He acts through people we might not anticipate.

We still need eyes to see and ears to hear (Matthew 13:16–17).
